Reflection on the Word of God

Jesus never concerned himself with externals. He always went to the heart of the matter. This was in contrast to the way the Pharisees were totally taken up with the details of the Law. In today's gospel, those details relate to ritual washings before eating. The Pharisees criticise Jesus and his disciples for ignoring some of these details. Jesus fumes with anger at their obsession with what is on the outside without any real concern for what truly matters, for what is within. It is in a person's heart that most evil has its root – “fornication, theft, murder, adultery, avarice, malice, deceit, indecency, envy, slander, pride, folly – all these evil things come from within and make a person unclean”.
It is the heart that matters.

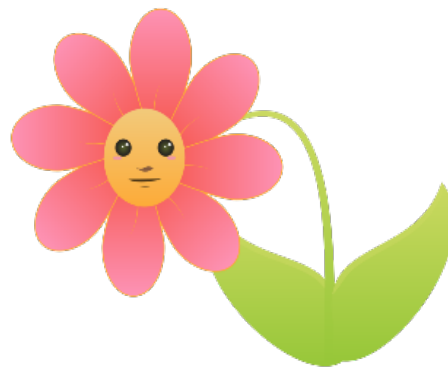
